The Charles T. Murphy Foreign Study Scholarship for \$2,000.00 for 2010 is being offered for a formal summer study program, such as the American Academy of Rome, The Vergilian Society (any tour conducted by the Society), or the American School of Classical Studies in Athens.

ELIGIBILITY

Anyone teaching Classics at the pre-college level in Ohio (i.e. elementary, middle or high school level), and who is currently a member of the Ohio Classical Conference and has held membership for three years (including 2009-2010).

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Submit the formal application form (may be downloaded from OCC website)
2. Make a formal statement about how you feel this opportunity will be used to enhance your teaching.
3. Submit two letters of recommendation from administrators, department chairs or colleagues familiar with you and your teaching.
4. Optional: Submit recent transcripts of graduate work and/or any other documents (e.g. awards won) which you feel support your application.

November 15, 2009 (must be received by this date)
