#14 Mentoring a certified OT colleague or other professional to improve the skills of the protégé, including role as a disciplinary monitor (mentor must be currently certified).	2 hours = 1 unit	18 units for professional role	Goals, objectives, and analysis of mentee performance (see <i>NBCOT Mentoring</i> form, at www.nbcot.org).
#15 Receiving mentoring from a certified occupational therapist or other professional in good standing to improve the skills of the protégé (mentee must be currently certified; must not be one's primary role).	2 hours = 1 unit	18 units for OT role or professional role	Goals and objectives established in collaboration with the mentor and self-analysis of performance (see <i>NBCOT Mentoring</i> form, at www.nbcot.org).
#16 Level II fieldwork direct supervision (must not be one's primary role).	1 unit per 1 week of supervision per student supervised	18 units for professional role	Letter of verification from school that includes the dates of fieldwork. DO NOT submit student evaluation form as verification. Co-supervision is acceptable; record dates and times when acting as primary student supervisor. Supervision of more than one student at a time is acceptable; record dates

#17 Level I fieldwork direct supervision (must not be one's primary role).	1 unit per student	18 units for professional role	and times of supervision provided to each student. Apply appropriate PDU number based on time spent supervising. Letter of verification from school including dates of fieldwork AND documented learning objectives and outcomes for the student.
#18 Fellowship training in specific area. Training must relate to either OT or professional role.	1 week = 2 units or	36 units for OT role 18 units for professional role	Awarded certificate from sponsoring organization including dates of training AND documented learning
