LEVEL ONE FIELDWORK OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of level one fieldwork, the student should be able to:

1. Demonstrate ability to establish and maintain a **basic level** therapeutic relationship with clients.
2. Display a **basic level** of ability to participate effectively in the supervisory process, including requesting and receiving feedback, and changing behavior accordingly.
3. Demonstrate **basic level** of ability to use the holistic approach when observing, evaluating, and treating patients/clients in a variety of settings.
4. Express a **basic level** of awareness of how occupational therapy theory is integrated into practice.
5. Identify personal and professional feelings associated with the client/therapist relationship and related staff or facility issues.
6. Perform **basic level** professional work behaviors.
7. Demonstrate **basic level** of written and verbal reporting skills.
8. Identify various evaluation tools and/or methods and their administration.
9. Show a **basic level** of ability to begin to formulate intervention plans, focusing on client-centered, occupation based practice.
10. Demonstrate a **basic level** of ability to review and revise group protocol where appropriate.
11. Differentiate the various roles of practitioner, educator, researcher, and manager in which an occupational therapist does or could function in the setting to which the student is assigned.
12. Identify and recognize multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary approaches to treatment.
13. Verbalize or demonstrate a basic understanding of the use of a client-centered, occupation focused, and evidenced-based practice approach within a site specific program.
