TOP 10 OCCUPATIONS EMPLOYING PERSONS WITH A BACHELORS IN SOCIAL WORK

Social Workers	37.4%
Top and mid-level managers, executives, administrators	9.4%
Other administrative (record clerks)	5.0%
Other management-related occupations	4.3%
Insurance, securities, real estate, business services	4.2%
Other Service Occupations, except health	3.9%
Educational and Vocational Counselors	2.7%
Personnel, training and labor relations specialists	2.4%
Other Health Occupations	2.4%
Secretaries, receptionists, typist	2.3%

ACTIVITIES ON THE JOB

- More than 1/2 of social workers spend a major amount of their time providing human services in social services agencies
 - About 10% spend most of their time engaging in administrative duties.
 - About 8% spend most of their typical work week in teaching activities.
 - About 7% spend most of their workweek in sales, marketing, and purchasing.
 - About 7% spend most of their time performing employee relations activities.

POST GRADUATION ACTIVITES

- About 36% of all social work graduates with a bachelor's degree proceed to earn a post graduate degree.
 - About 60% of master's degrees earned by social work undergraduates are earned in social work.
 - About 11% of master's degrees earned by social work undergraduates are earned in education.
 - About 8 % of master's degrees earned by social work undergraduates are earned in psychology.
 - Only 1% of social work bachelor's degrees recipients go on to earn a doctorate. 35% of those doctorates are in psychology, 28% are in education and 26% are in social work.
