TOP 10 OCCUPATIONS EMPLOYING PERSONS WITH A BACHELORS IN A FOREIGN LANGUAGE

Teachers, secondary school	14.8%
Top and mid-level managers, executives, and administrators	8.4%
Sales occupations, including retail	7.1%
Secretaries, receptionists, typists	6.7%
Other administrative (record clerks)	6.0%
Other management-related occupations	4.6%
Insurance, securities, real estate, business services	4.4%
Teachers, elementary school	3.9%
Other service occupations, except health	3.9%

ACTIVITIES ON THE JOB

- 43% of employed foreign languages graduates regularly perform management and administrative duties at work.
 - Sales, purchasing, and marketing activities are regularly performed by 26% of all employed foreign language graduates.
 - The majority of the workweek of 9% of foreign language grads is spent providing professional services such as financial services and another 9% consider computer applications, programming and system-development duties as a major part of their job.

POST GRADUATION ACTIVITIES

- 45% proceed to earn a post-graduate degree. 34% earn a master's degree; 6% graduate with a doctorate; 5% earn a professional degree
- Only 28% earn a master's degree in foreign languages. About 28% are earned in education and 13% in business administration and management.
- About 90% of all professional degrees are in the field of law.
