SELECTING A MAJOR

ASSESS YOUR VALUES, SKILLS, AND INTERESTS

- Meet with your academic advisor. Talk about your career interests and learn about courses that match them.
- Take your core curriculum classes. Broaden your experience by exploring a variety of subjects through introductory courses
- Learn how to study effectively. Strengthen your time-management skills. Check out the Learning Assistance Center (LAC). Future employers will want to see a strong academic record.
- Use computer programs to identify career choices. Meet with an Assistant Director in the Career Services Center to learn how to take the FOCUS II Career Assessment to discover your skills, values, interests, and personality to match them with careers that are right for you.
- Get feedback. Ask friends, family, advisors, professors, or employers who are familiar with your unique skills and characteristics to help identify your strengths.
