TOP 10 OCCUPATIONS EMPLOYING PERSONS WITH A BACHELORS IN SOCIOLOGY

Top and mid-level managers, executives, administrators	13.9%
Social Workers	10.0%
Other administrative (e.g., records clerks, telephone operators)	5.7%
Other management-related occupations	5.7%
Sales occupations, including retail	5.2%
Other marketing and sales occupations	4.1%
Secretaries, receptionists, typists	4.1%
Personnel, training, and labor relations specialists	4.1%
Accountants, auditors, other financial specialists	3.5%

POST GRADUATION ACTIVITIES

- About 33% proceed to earn a post-graduate degree.
- About 25% of the master's degrees are earned in the field of education.
- A substantial number of the master's degrees are earned in business and psychology.
