[International Student Services](#): Assist students, especially students from abroad, in achieving their educational goals and to provide all Xavier students opportunities for growth through cross cultural interaction.

[Office of Multicultural Affairs](#): Provides direct support to Black, Latino, Asian American and Native American students as well as advocacy to other minoritized groups that aids in their holistic development. Also provides diversity awareness programs to enrich the academic, cultural and social experiences of Xavier students.

[Psychological Services Center](#): Provides an on-campus center that provides a wide variety of psychological services to students at Xavier University.

[Student Success & Retention](#): Develops, plans, coordinates, and administers the freshman experience programs that significantly improve the academic and social integration necessary to enhance the quality of the college experience. They continue to assist students as they matriculate with programs that provide financial and academic support, social adjustment and academic advising.

[Student Support Services/TRiO](#): An educational program funded by the US Dept of Education, whose goal is to graduate eligible students and prepare them for post – baccalaureate education or career. They are committed to providing an academic, professional and personal support system that guides students.

[The Women's Center](#): Provides advocacy and resources, advances learning and academic excellence, and promotes research focusing on women, girls and gender in and effort to unite people in centering women.
