



## GRADUATE RECORD EXAM (GRE)

The GRE (Graduate Record Exam) General Test measures verbal reasoning, quantitative reasoning, critical thinking and analytical skills. The exam consists of three sections: verbal, quantitative and analytical writing. Computer-based testing is the most common option of test taking.

### TAKING THE GRE: TESTING LOCATIONS

Computer based testing is offered year-round with appointments scheduled on a first-come, first-serve basis at the following nearby locations:

#### 1) University of Cincinnati, Psychological Service Center

- Approximate Wait Time: 2-3 weeks for appointment
- Score Submission: Scores will be mailed to your address and designated institutions within 10-15 days of your test date.

- Score Submission: Scores will be mailed to your address and designated institutions within 10-15 days of your test date.

**Registration Fee:** \$195\*\*

**Test Duration:** 4 hours in length

**Repeating the GRE:** You may take the General Test only once per 60 days and no more than five times within any 12-month period. This includes scores canceled on a test taken previously.
