- 50-60 employers: customer service, banks, health care, security, manufacturing, food service, hospitality, etc.
- Free Services: job readiness, search, retention, advancement, legal advocacy, tuition assistance, counseling, transportation assistance, etc.



### **Jobs for Cincinnati Graduates 513.631.4400**

In-School: 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grades; Out-of-School: age 16-21 without diploma/GED

- Get high school diploma, GED/prep, tutoring, remediation, OGT prep
- Gain Skills: job attainment, job survival, basic competencies, leadership self development, among others
- Individualized Career Plan: college, advanced training, or employment
- One year of follow-up to help with transition to post-secondary or work
