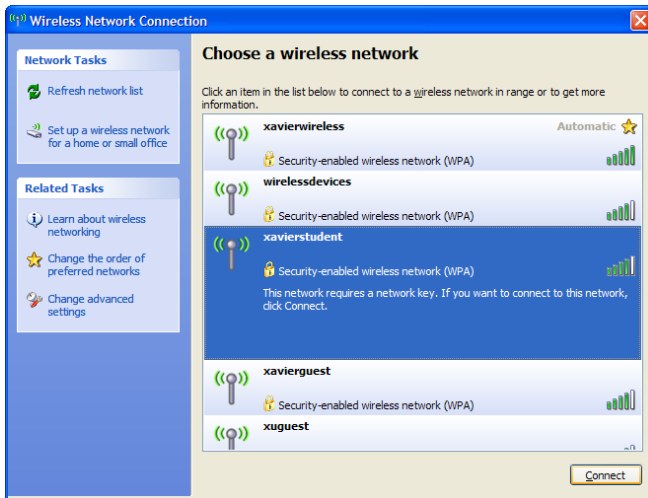


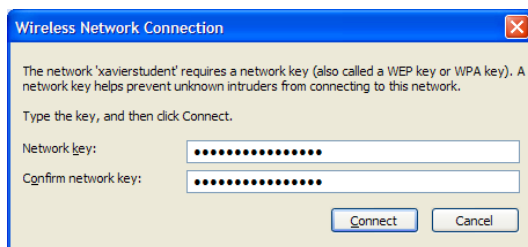

Connecting to Xavier's Student Wireless Network (XP Users)

1. Click **Start** and open the **Control Panel**. In the Control Panel, double click on **Network Connections**.
2. Right click on **Wireless Network Connections** and select **View Available Wireless Networks**. Select **xavierstudent** and click **Connect**.



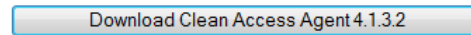
3. You will be asked for a Pre-Shared Key (PSK). Type in **only4students** and click **Connect**.



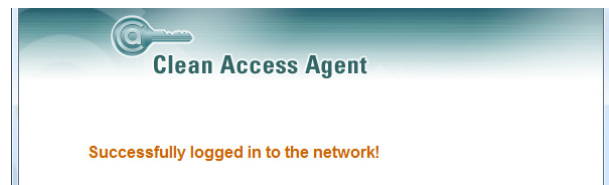
4. Once connected, open Internet Explorer. It will prompt you to login.



5. Once logged in you be prompted to download the **Cisco Clean Access Agent**. Download the Agent.



6. Once **Clean Access** has downloaded, it will prompt you for your username and password. You will see the **successfully logged in** message. You are now connected to **xavierstudent**.
