The network adapter property sheet in Windows Vista* provides information about the network adapter and driver on the computer.

Use one of the following methods to access information on the network adapter, driver version, and Intel® PROSet version.

Device Manager

Click Start » Control Panel.
Click System and Maintenance.
Click Device Manager.
Click the + symbol in front of Network Adapters to expand the section.
Right-click the network adapter.
Click Properties .
Click the Driver tab to see the driver version.
Click the Link Speed tab to see the Intel® PROSet version. NOTE: The Link Speed tab will not appear if Intel PROSet is not installed.

Click Start » Computer.
Click Manage and click Continue.
Click Device Manager.
Click the + symbol in front of Network Adapters to expand the section.
Right-click the network adapter.
Click Properties.
Click the Driver tab to see the driver version.
Click the Link Speed tab to see the Intel PROSet version. NOTE: The Link Speed tab will not appear if Intel PROSet is not installed.

Click Network and Internet.
Click Network and Sharing Center.
Right-click network Network Connection.

Click Properties.

Click Configure.
