Statement of Scholarship

Two Scholarships, each worth \$9,500, will be awarded to undergraduates presently in their sophomore or junior year who plan to be full-time students for both semesters, 2009-2010. Nominees from any of the three colleges are welcome.

Norms for Selecting the Winners

Primary Norm: Student's dedication to and excellence in the humanities. This criterion is explained in more detail on the application form.

Directives for Application

1. Nominations for these scholarships are made only through academic departments. Departments may nominate a candidate or candidates to the Financial Aid and Scholarship Committee for consideration. Any student wishing to be considered should express an interest to the chair of the department in which she/he is majoring. Application forms will be available in the office of the chair.
2. These scholarships are for ***tuition*** only and may not be applied to room, board or other fees. If the winner is already the recipient of tuition restricted financial aid, such as a Xavier sponsored scholarship, an adjustment in the Savage Scholarship stipend may be necessary.
3. The Chair should send all nomination materials, including only one letter of recommendation, to Paul Calme, Chair of the Financial Aid and Scholarship Committee, c/o J. Snodgrass, Alter 124 (ML 3141).
