

Financial Assistance Form for Catholic School Teachers, Off-Site Master of Education students and Withrow High School Teachers

This form is for non-need based graduate study grants that are administered through the Office of Graduate Services. The following prospective and/or current students should complete this form:

- Employees of Catholic schools in Kentucky and Ohio
- Students who have taken 4 courses at one of our off-site Master of Education locations should use this form to apply to receive a full tuition grant for their last three credit hour course. Students who have received other need based grants can not apply for the off-site master of education grant.
- Teachers at Withrow High School should use this grant form to apply for a 50-percent tuition grant for up to nine credit hours each academic year (summer, fall, and spring). If Withrow teachers enroll for more than nine credit hours in a given academic year, they will be eligible for need-based grants based on the evaluation of their FAFSA.

Please note:

- You are not eligible for one of these grants if you receive full employer tuition reimbursement or if you are a Xavier employee or employee's dependent.
- Those who are receiving tuition assistance through a graduate assistantship will be evaluated on a case by case basis to determine if they are eligible for one of these specific grants.
- Graduate students in **Theology** are encouraged to apply for a grant that is need based. Need is determined by completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You can complete it on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Graduate students in Business, Health Services Administration, and Psychology are not eligible for these grants and should contact their respective department for grant information.

_____ **Withrow High School Teacher Grant**

Xavier University has a special partnership with Withrow High School. As part of this partnership, Xavier has agreed to offer a 50% tuition grant for up to a maximum of nine (9) credit hours each academic year for Withrow High School teachers. Those Withrow High School teachers taking more than nine (9) credit hours during an academic year are eligible to apply for the general graduate study grant
