Funds

Accommodation and books, medical insurance & other fees are estimated expenses.

Living with Relative or Friend Off-Campus

If you plan to live with a relative or friend off-campus, we require a notarized statement from your relative or friend stating that you will be living "free of charge" at their house.

If a letter is provided, you will only need to submit proof of funds for accommodation in the following amounts:

- One Year: \$5,500 (not \$11,000 as stated in the table above)
- One Semester: \$1,830 (not \$3,660 as stated in the table above)

Dependents

The following additional funds must be shown in order to issue immigration papers for dependents:

- First dependent: \$3,500
- Other dependents: \$3,000 per dependent
