

GCLC Visitors Borrowing Privileges: These borrowing privileges are available for patrons with a current library card from a Greater Cincinnati Library Consortium (GCLC) institution. First time borrowers must register in-person at the circulation desk in the library where you will be issued a GCLC Library Card. Bring a current library card from a GCLC institution and your driver's license with you.

**These limits reflect the maximum amount of charges you can have on your library record. After this amount is reached you are blocked from borrowing additional items and from placing holds.

Renewing Materials: You may renew materials online using My Library Record at xplora.xu.edu/patroninfo/ or by contacting the circulation desk in person or by telephone at 513 745-3881. Materials may not be renewed if a hold has been placed on the item by another patron, the item has been recalled by a faculty member, it is too soon to renew (you may renew materials as soon as 7 days before the item is due), charges on your library record exceed the maximum limits, or renewing exceeds the maximum number of renewals allowed.

Overdue Notices & Bills: All overdue notices and bills for lost items are sent by postal mail to your home address. Notices are sent 1 day, 1 week and 2 weeks after the item is overdue; replacement bills are sent 1 month after the item is overdue.

Returned Lost Materials: If a lost item is found and returned after you were billed for the lost item, the library will issue a credit or refund of \$85 if the item is returned within 1 year of the date you were billed. Overdue fines are not refunded.

Grace Period: You may return or renew an item up to 7 days after the item is due without accruing any overdue fines. However, if the item is not returned or renewed, retroactive charges begin on the eighth day at 80¢/item for XU books and \$4/item for XU audiovisuals.
