THE FOLLOWING AWARDS WILL ALSO BE PRESENTED:

Antonio Johnson Scholars: Students of African descent with a 3.0 or higher cumulative G.P.A. will receive an award.

Antonio Johnson Scholarship: A current junior of African descent with a 3.0 or higher cumulative G.P.A. will be selected to receive the Antonio Johnson Scholarship. The student will be selected by the Antonio Johnson Scholarship Selection Committee, which is comprised of students, faculty, and administrators.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Student Awards Committee will select the recipients of the Outstanding Freshman, Outstanding Sophomore, Outstanding Senior, Outstanding Service, Outstanding Leadership, Faculty and Staff Support Awards. Persons on the Committee who are nominated will not participate in the discussion or voting for that particular award. The BSA Executive Board will vote for the Committee of the Year Award. A separate selection committee in conjunction with the CAPS program will vote for Non-Traditional Student Scholarship Award (including 2 AJ committee members).
