REQUIREMENTS

Participants in the competition must:

- Display musicianship and talent (voice or instrument).
- Be admitted to the University before scheduling an audition.
- Intend to major in music or music education.

All awards are contingent upon admission to Xavier University.

RENEWABILITY

The music scholarship and grants are renewable each year for four years provided the recipient maintains full-time status as a music major, a 3.00 cumulative grade point average in music and a 2.50 GPA overall.



WHAT YOU NEED TO PREPARE FOR THE AUDITION

Students interested in one or more of the areas below should come prepared with music selections (two copies if you require an accompanist), and:

VOICE STUDENTS: Prepare two music selections of contrasting styles and time periods. One of these should be in a language other than English. (You may want to consult with your private instructor or music director.) Students should be prepared to sight-read.

INSTRUMENTAL STUDENTS: Prepare two music selections of contrasting styles and time periods. (You may want to consult with your private instructor or music director.) Students should be prepared to play two-octave major and minor scales.
