Graduation Ceremony Policy: A **doctoral** student can **PARTICIPATE** in the May graduation ceremony only after completion of all program requirements including dissertation. A **master's** student can **PARTICIPATE** in the May graduation ceremony only after successful completion of their course work, Oral Comprehensive Exam and Thesis Proposal.
