Student Progress: No more than six years may elapse between admission to the M.A. program and completion of work for the degree (including thesis). No more than eight years may elapse between admission to the Psy.D. program and completion of work for the degree (including dissertation).

Graduation Ceremony Policy: A **doctoral** student can **PARTICIPATE** in the May graduation ceremony only after completion of all program requirements including dissertation. A **master's** student can **PARTICIPATE** in the May graduation ceremony only after successful completion of their course work, Oral Comprehensive Exam and Thesis Proposal
