 2 Beginning Summer 1996, the definition of full-time enrollment status for certain reports involving undergraduate students changed from fifteen or more credit hours to twelve or more; full-time for graduate students changed from twelve or more credit hours to nine or more. This brings Xavier into alignment with federal reporting guidelines.
