



## Hearst Community Scholarship Application, 2010-2011

The William Randolph Hearst Endowed Scholarship Fund provides one annual scholarship of \$2,500 to an undergraduate student from three communities that surround the University: Evanston, Avondale, or Norwood. To be eligible, applicants must be incoming, first-year, full-time students who have been admitted to Xavier and have financial need. Because the scholarship seeks to bring underrepresented students to Xavier, applicants' cultural heritage and whether they are of the first generation in their family to attend college will be considered among many factors in the selection process. Hearst Scholarship recipients will maintain the awards for their four years at Xavier, as long as they remain in good academic standing.
