## 2023-24 Game Night Parking Advisory:

## **R-3 LOT CLOSED ON GAME NIGHTS**

Per the University Parking Policy, <u>all students parked in the R-3 Lot east of the Cohen Center must</u> <u>move their cars at least 4 hours before the start of all home Men's basketball games.</u>

To facilitate clearing this lot, we have worked with the game day parking management staff to reserve several lots on campus to be held exclusively for Xavier students and employees on game nights; these locations are as follows:

• <u>GAME NIGHT STUDENT RESERVED LOTS:</u> R-1 Lot, R-2 Lot, Smith Hall, University Drive, Gallagher Lot, Innovation Center Lot, and Admission/CLC lots. These lots are first come, first served. \*Students parking in a faculty/staff lot will need to move their vehicle back to their designated lot by 8 a.m. the next day.

Other Alternative Parking Locations - NOT RESERVED:

Unpaved gravel lots located south of Dana Avenue\*\*, Alumni Center, Heidt Champions Center Lot, West Lot, Elet Lot, Sycamore Lot, Armory Lot, and Central Utility Plant. Lots are first come, first served.

Students parking in these Reserved and Unreserved alternate lots (other than R1 and R2) must move their car back to R-3 by 12:00 p.m. the day following the game.

\*\*These gravel lots will have parking attendants charging a \$10 parking fee to ticket holders; if you have a valid Xavier faculty/staff or student permit, you are <u>NOT</u> subject to this fee.

WINTER BREAK NOTE: This same policy is in effect over winter break. Vehicles parked in R-3 during this time may be towed at the owner's expense.

As with the <u>parking towing policy</u>, any vehicle not moved by remove vehicle time is subject to relocation/towing and fees.
