- If you have not heard from your advisor by March 20, please reach out to them to make an appointment.
- Look up holds on your account and resolve them before scheduling. Even if you have holds, you should still schedule a meeting with your advisor so you can register as soon as the holds are cleared.
- Be sure to double check the dates of the classes that you are registering for to ensure that the dates work with your summer plans.
- Remember--You have three attempts to pass a class, including failing grades and withdrawals. Be aware and talk to your advisor.
