Michael Naughton has been a teacher for over 39 years on both secondary and university levels. He is currently the director of the Center for Catholic Studies at the University of St. Thomas (Minnesota), where he holds the Koch Chair in Catholic Studies. Dr. Naughton is author, co-author and coeditor of 12 books and monographs and over 60 articles. His most recent book is called What We Hold in Trust: Rediscovering the Purpose of Catholic Higher Education (with coauthors Don Briel and Ken Goodpaster). Dr. Naughton serves on several boards including the University of Mary, St. Agnes School's Headmaster's Advisory Board and Catholic Eldercare. He is also board chair of Reell Precision Manufacturing, a producer of torque solutions for transportation, consumer electronics, medical and office automation products with offices in the U.S., Netherlands and China. Dr. Naughton is married with five children and two grandchildren. He and his wife Teresa are parishioners at Holy Spirit Catholic Church and the Cathedral in St. Paul, MN.
