



 **GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT** 

Gross Domestic Product is the value of all final goods and services produced in the country. GDP is the broadest measure of economic activity and the principal indicator of economic performance. Built as a system of interlocking sector accounts, the GDP report provides the most comprehensive reading of the nation's health.

Also released with GDP statistics is the GDP deflator. Two calculations of the GDP deflator are reported: implicit deflator and a fixed-weight deflator. The implicit deflator is the ratio of current-dollar GDP to constant dollar GDP. The fixed-weight deflator is the sum of the deflators for individual components of GDP with each component weighted by its share of real GDP in the base period, and consequently a better gauge of inflation.


