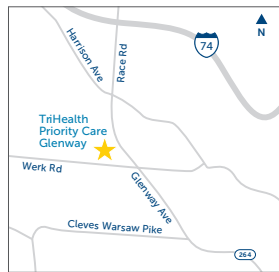

As part of TriHealth's full spectrum of care, Priority Care offers:

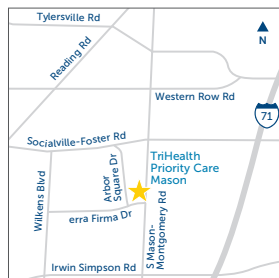
- Walk-in care for urgent but less-than-emergent issues
