

## Student Experiences with Faculty

This infographic of the National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE) series explores student perceptions of two engagement indicators: Student-Faculty Interaction and Effective Teaching Practices.

The NSSE infographic series features selected results from the NSSE administered to Xavier first-years and seniors in spring 2020; data collection ended just before the switch to remote learning. 




