- + **Clubs and Organizations:** With 160+ student groups from academic organizations to arts, language and culture and identity-based groups, there's no shortage of opportunities to amplify your voice and ignite your sense of purpose.
- + **Athletics and Fitness:** Check out a sporting event with one of Xavier's NCAA Division I athletic teams, join an intermural sports team or venture over to the HUB (Health United Building) with three indoor basketball courts, a three-lane running track, three fitness studios, a four lane indoor pool, and recreation gym spaces for treadmills, stationary bikes, ellipticals and weight-lifting machines to stay active year-round.
- + **International Student and Scholar Services:** Xavier's dedicated office provides the support you'll need to navigate student life, including a special orientation, help with your arrival, airport pick-up, shopping trips, a tour of Cincinnati and many events throughout the year to help expand your network and continue to build a community in your new home.

Housing

- + On-campus options include six residence halls with most featuring suite-style living arrangements with private bedrooms and a shared bathroom.
- + Student housing is equipped with shared, free laundry facilities, wireless internet, air conditioning, cable and comfortable furniture.
- + Students are required to live on campus for the first two years.

Dining

- + Xavier's on-campus residents are offered dining plans with unlimited access to Hoff Dining Commons. All other students can choose from our six dining plans.
- + Students choose from multiple dining stations including daily chef specials, vegetarian dining options and a gluten-free food station. Food is made to order and sourced locally whenever possible, sometimes even from our own campus garden.
- + In addition to the main dining hall, students enjoy several additional dining options on campus including Bull Market, Burger 513, Starbucks, Currito Burrito and more.

Safety

- + Xavier's on-campus police department provides 24/7 police patrols, blue light assistance phones located throughout campus buildings and grounds, secured card access residence halls, mandatory fire safety training in each residence hall and escort services after dark through XUPD dispatch.

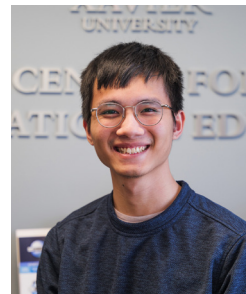

Merit Scholarships

All admitted international undergraduate students are considered for awards starting at \$22,000 per academic year, renewable for all four years of study. Additional competitive scholarships are available — visit xavier.edu/intl-schol to learn more and apply.

Requirements

- No application fee
- Apply via Xavier online application or Common Application
- Official academic transcripts (in English)
- SAT/ACT test-optional; GMAT/GRE optional for most graduate programs, required for MSCA and MED programs
- Writing sample/essay for undergraduate admission
- Resume/CV, letters of recommendation, and statement of purpose required for graduate admission
- Proof of English proficiency via one official score report: IELTS 6.5, TOEFL 79, Duolingo 110, PTE 55, or Cambridge English 176

Important Dates:

August 1: Application opens

December 1: Deadline for Fall intake competitive scholarships, nursing program application, and priority application deadline for honors programs

November 15:* Recommended application deadline for Spring intake

March 1:* Recommended application deadline for Fall intake

**Applicants will be considered after these dates on a rolling admission basis.*
