
• Get an internship!

## OPT (1 year) STEM OPT (2 years)

Then, your employer may choose to sponsor you for an employment-based visa.





# H-1Bs

- Specialty Occupations (that require at least a bachelor's degree)
- Degree MUST be related to the job offered
- Very popular for STEM fields
- LOTTERY! 85,000 ARE GUARANTEED, government usually increases the amount to around 130,000
- Preference for U.S. Master's Students
- Lottery registration takes place in March for the upcoming "fiscal year" beginning October 1st.
- Up to 3 year validity.






# **TN Visas**

- Available to Canadian and Mexican Nationals.
- Valid for 3 years at a time and can be extended indefinitely.
- List of qualifying occupations (and qualifying degrees and licenses for those occupations)
- Can be issued by CBP at the border or through an application to USCIS

## E-2 Visas (Investor Visa)

- Allows nationals of treaty countries to enter the U.S. to invest in or work for a qualifying business.
- Eligible applicants: Investors and key employees of investors.
- Requires a substantial investment in a U.S. business.
- Business must be more than marginal (should create jobs and contribute to the economy).
- The investor must have **at least 50% ownership** or control of the business.
- Employees must have executive, supervisory, or essential skills.
- The visa is **temporary** but can be renewed indefinitely as long as the business remains operational.
- Spouses can obtain work authorization, and children (under 21) can study but not work.

## IMMIGRANT VISAS (green cards)

There are 2 Main Types:

**Employment-Based** 

And

**Family-Based** 





### Types of Employment-Based Immigrant Visas:

### EB-1: Priority Workers (No labor certification required)

- **EB-1A:** Extraordinary ability in sciences, arts, education, business, or athletics (self-petition allowed).
- **EB-1B:** Outstanding professors and researchers with international recognition.
- **EB-1C:** Multinational executives and managers transferring to a U.S. office.

### EB-2: Advanced Degree & Exceptional Ability (Labor certification required unless waived)

- EB-2 (Advanced Degree): Master's degree (or bachelor's + 5 years of experience).
- EB-2 (Exceptional Ability): Significant expertise in sciences, arts, or business.
   EB-2 NIW: National Interest Waiver for individuals whose work benefits the U.S. (self-petition allowed).

### EB-3: Skilled Workers & Professionals (Labor certification required)

- **Professionals:** Jobs requiring a **bachelor's degree**.
- Skilled Workers: Jobs requiring 2+ years of experience.
- Other Workers: Jobs requiring less than 2 years of training

### And, EB-5 INVESTOR VISA

EB-5: Immigrant Investors (No labor certification required)

- Invest **\$1.05M (\$800K in targeted areas)** in a U.S. business.
- Must create/preserve **10+ jobs** for U.S. workers.
