Ebook (similar to print, but note placement of term 'ebook')

Author Last Name, First Name. *Book Title*. Publisher, year of publication. E-book, Publisher, year of publication.

Brown, Kathleen M. *Undoing Slavery: Bodies, Race, and Rights in the Age of Abolition*. E-book. University of Pennsylvania Press, 2023.

Work in an Anthology

Author Last Name, First Name. "Title of Part of Book Being Cited." *Title of Anthology*, edited by First Name Last Name(s), edition (if any), Publisher, Publication Date, Page(s).

Godfrey, Mollie. "Getting Graphic with *Kindred*: The Neo-Slave Narrative of the Black Lives Matter Movement." *Slavery and the Post-Black Imagination*, edited by Bertram D. Ashe and Ilka Saal, University of Washington Press, 2020, pp. 83-105.

Scholarly article from a database

Author Last Name, First Name. "Article Title." *Journal Title*, volume number, issue number, date of publication including month or season, if any, page numbers. Name of the database, DOI or permalink if available; otherwise, shortened URL of database.

Short document from a website

Author Last Name, First Name. "Title of the Document or Page." *Website Title*, Sponsor of website unless it's the same as title, Update date, URL. Date of access if no update date given.

Entire website w/organization as author
