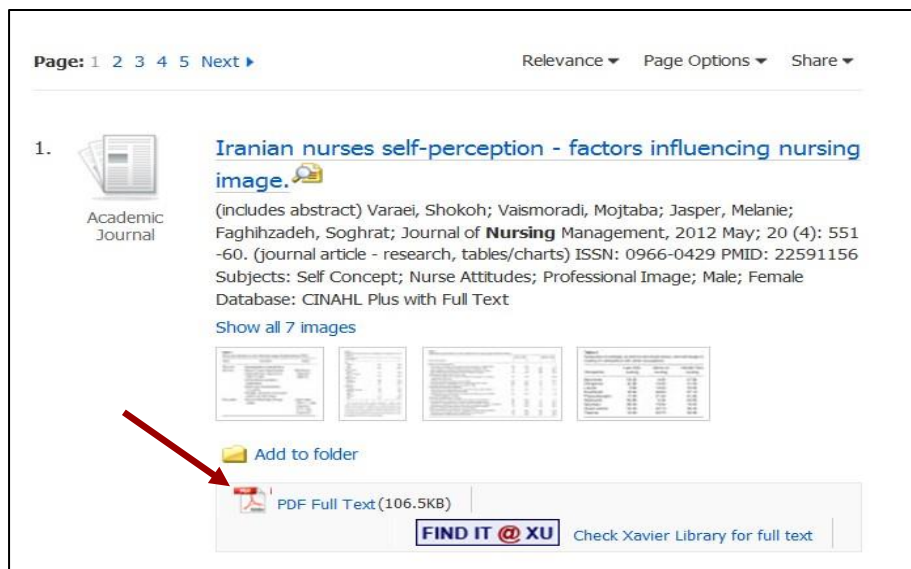
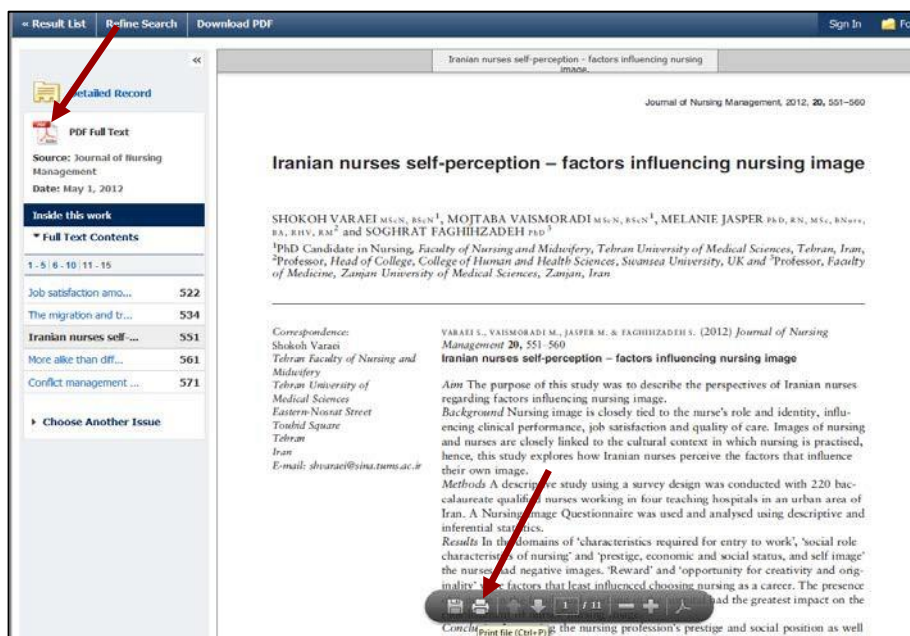


THREE WAYS TO OBTAIN COPIES OF ARTICLES IN SEARCH@XU

1. **Embedded Full-Text:** Some articles provide a direct link to the full text right in the search results.
 - a. Just click the PDF Full Text icon or link to open the full text of this article.



- b. The full text of the article will display in a new Search@XU window. Use the PDF icon in the left column or the print icon in the floating menu to print.

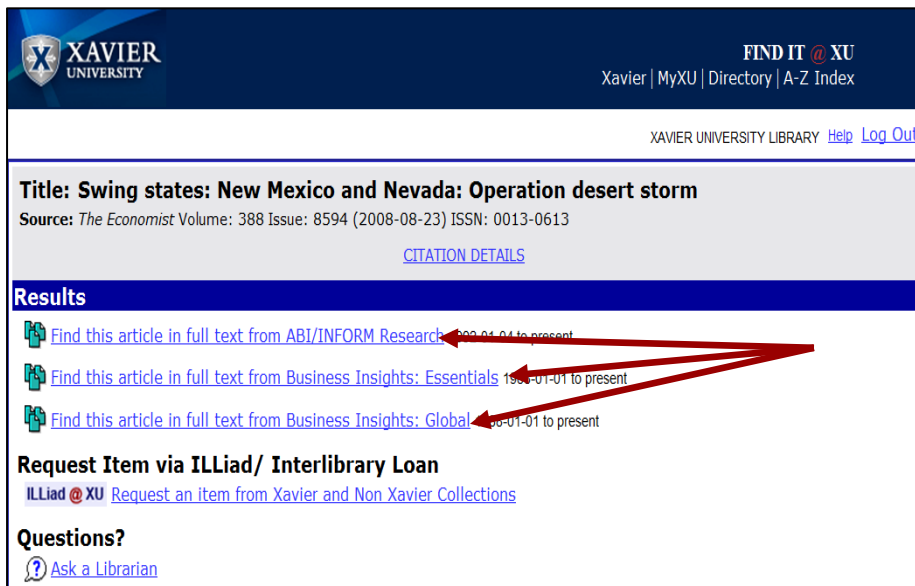


2. **Find It @ XU:** Some articles link out to other library resources that provide the full text.

a. Just click the Find It @ XU icon.



b. The Find IT @ XU window will open. If the full text of the article is available in other library resources, one or more links will display under *Results*. Any one of these will ultimately provide the full text of the article. If one doesn't work, try another.



3. **Interlibrary Loan:** The full texts of some articles have to be obtained from other libraries.

- a. Just click the Find It @ XU icon.
