HEALTHCARE IN PRACTICE #17 – Monday, February 10, 2020

Xavier's health professions students gathered in the HUB 4th Floor Event Commons on Monday, February 10, 2020 for the 17th presentation in our "Healthcare in Practice" (HIP) series. Each semester Xavier's health professions students welcome a speaker on a topic of broad interest to all the disciplines.

HIP #17 featured HSA faculty member and MS-HECOR program director, **Dr. Peter Mallow**, who presented this thoughtprovoking topic, "Value Based Care is in Front of Us, Behind Us, to Our Sides: It Can't Get Away This Time".

A healthcare payment system based on the value of care, i.e. improve patient experience, reduce the cost of healthcare, and improve the health of populations vs. payment based on volume, e.g. how many patients, how many surgeries, how many lab tests, etc. is gaining steam. Dr. Mallow spoke about the economics of healthcare costs in the USA; reining in the US healthcare costs is a daunting task when you consider this reality:

#1 Economy in the World = USA = \$20.5 Trillion = China = 13.6 Trillion #2 Economy in the World = 4.97 Trillion #3 Economy in the World = Japan 3.94 Trillion #4 Economy in the World = Germany #5 Economy in the World = USA Healthcare = 3.82 Trillion #6 Economy in the World United Kingdom = 2.85 Trillion = 2.77 Trillion #7 Economy in the World = France #8 Economy in the World = India 2.72 Trillion
