

**BG Robert Clifford Goetz**  
**Class of 1963**

Brigadier General "Bob" Goetz, of Indianapolis, IN formerly of Covington, KY was a Xavier University Distinguished Military Graduate, Commissioned U.S.A.R., Finance Corps, and received a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (Accounting), in June, 1963. He also held a Master of Business Administration from Indiana University in 1972.

His military education includes the Field Artillery Officer Basic Course, Fort Sill, OK; Finance Officers Basic and Advanced Course, Fort Benjamin Harrison, IN; United States Army Command and General Staff College, Fort Leavenworth, KS; and United States Army War College, Carlisle, PA.
