Beth's versatile career spans 20 years both as a Military Police Officer and later as a member of the Nurse Corps, deploying to forward operating bases as Commander and Surgical Nurse.

Beth graduated from Xavier University with a BS degree and was commissioned as 2LT in the Military Police Corps in 1986. She served 6 years, then resigned her commission to become a nurse. She graduated from Ursuline College in 2006 and was re-commissioned in the Army Reserves in the Nurse Corps. She works full time in the Operating Room at University Hospitals, Cleveland Medical Center in Cleveland, Ohio.

As a Military Police Officer, she served in Heilbronn, Germany as Platoon Leader for the 194th MP Company and as the Physical Security Officer for the 101st Ordnance Battalion. She served as the Commander and OR nurse for the 848th Forward Surgical Team in Twinsburg, Ohio and deployed the Team to Afghanistan in 2013 in support of Operation Enduring Freedom from May-Dec 2014. She served as Commander for 3 years. She remained with the Team after command due to the challenge and high tempo of the FST. She recently deployed in Eastern Afghanistan (Oct 2018 through Aug 2019) supporting SOTF-A acting as a Site OIC and Operating Room Nurse in support of Operation Freedom's Sentinel. LTC McCluskey now serves with the 7301st MTSB at Joint Base MDL in NJ.

In addition, she possesses numerous trauma certifications which testify to her proficiency in healthcare.
