



SAFETY BASICS

YOU, YOUR STUFF AND YOUR CAR

Whether you are new to Xavier or returning for another year, here are some basic rules to help keep yourself, your car and your stuff safe and secure.

- See it, hear it, report it If you see something suspicious on campus, call Xavier Police at 513-745-1000
- Always lock your door: Thefts occur in residence halls and campus buildings most often when rooms are not secured.
- Always lock your car : Don't leave anything in plain view. Remove valuables or lock them in the trunk. Check on your car occasionally if it is parked for long periods of time.
- Protect valuables: If possible, leave valuables at home. Otherwise, store valuable possessions, such as credit cards and jewelry in a small safe in your room.
- Guard electronics: Don't leave electronics, such as laptops, cell phones or iPods, unattended. They're easy to steal, conceal and dispose of quickly.
- Watch your books : Mark textbooks with your name and Banner ID number. Don't leave books or backpacks unattended
- Stay sober: Alcohol impairs judgment and increases your chances of being a victim of crime. Xavier enforces state law: The legal age for drinking in Ohio is 21.
- Use common sense: Walk with assurance so you're not an easy target for criminals. Don't flash cash. If you need help, call Xavier
