UNDERSTANDING THE NEW DASHBOARD

Xavier University

For many years, DegreeWorks at Xavier University has used the original, classic dashboard to display information about academic progress to students. In September 2023, Xavier moved DegreeWorks to a new dashboard, called the responsive dashboard. It is more modern, cleaner, and designed to display well on tablets and phones. The original, classic dashboard has been discontinued.

Student Header

In the Student Header block, the following information is displayed: ID, name, degree, level, classification, major(s), minor, concentration, program, advisor(s), overall credits, overall GPA.

In the new dashboard, only certain fields with available information will display in the Student Header block. (i.e. if the student does not have a minor or a concentration, etc. then the field header will not show.)

Degree Progress

The Degree Progress area shows the student's GPA and that the audit includes in-progress and preregistered courses.

Degree Requirements

The blocks located below the Degree Progress section, list the requirements needed to complete a degree. Requirements are displayed in a radio button format that state whether the requirement has been fulfilled or not. Each block header also displays an **Incomplete**, **In-Progress**, and **Complete** label based on the status of the requirement.

Users may collapse and expand blocks in the audit for quick navigation. Use the **up or down arrows** within each block to collapse and expand a single block.

Individual blocks will show the Course, Title, Grade, Credits, Term a course was taken, and Repeated if a course was taken more than once to the right of the requirement. In-Progress courses will show with “REG” in the Grade column and the course credit will show in parentheses.

Fall Through Courses

Fall Through courses are classes that are not counted toward specific requirements within the Core Curriculum or the major, concentration or minor. These courses still count towards the total credit hours earned displayed at the top of the audit. The grades of the courses within this block factor into the student’s cumulative GPA.

What-If and Look Ahead

Previously, the What-if function that applies the students' courses to a different major, minor, concentration, etc. and the Look Ahead function that allows for potential courses to be reviewed against the degree plan to see where the course(s) would fall into a student's audit, were separate.

In the new dashboard, the Look Ahead function is now labeled Future Classes and is combined with the What-if function.

The user must still select the catalog year, degree type and major (some majors also require a concentration) but now the user has the option to include or not include In-progress and Preregistered classes.

The Additional areas of study feature also gives the option to add another major, minor, etc. when using the What-if function.
