Double Room Information Sheet

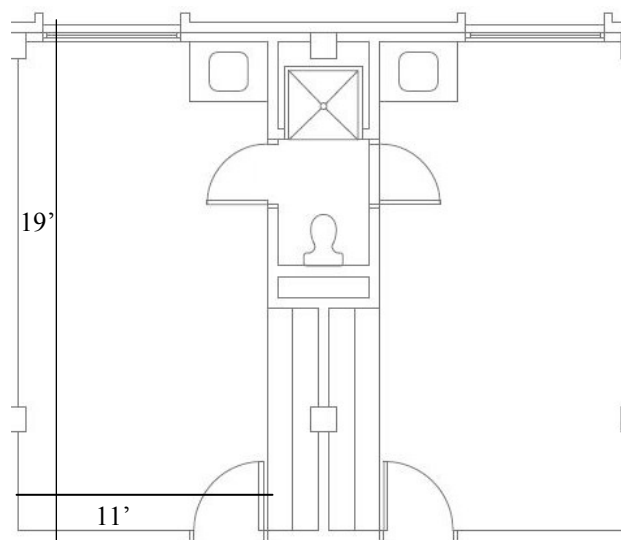
Kuhlman hall houses first year students. The floors are co-ed by wing. Every two rooms share an adjoining bathroom (called a suite). Each room has loftable beds, a desk and a chair per student. There are built in shelving, dresser and closet units.

Double rooms are two students sharing one bedroom. There is a Resident Assistant (RA) on each floor that is responsible for community development and mentoring the residents. The RA staff report to the Hall Director, a master-level professional staff member assigned to live and work with the students of their building.
