We are committed to cultivating a transparent and equitable funding process that uplifts every student organization. Our goal is to ensure that every organization has a clear framework for how funds are allocated. We will ensure that every student voice is heard and represented. We will host regular collaborative sessions and personally work with student leaders to answer any questions raised. Our administration will strive to make sure that each organization has the resources they need to continue to thrive at Xavier. Improving Student Spaces on Campus to Promote Community Building: r This past summer, Nick took part in the campus masterplan development process. He consistently advocated for improvements to the Yard, Academic Mall and Cintas Center to President Hanycz and other prominent members of the Xavier Administration. We plan to build on the work we have already started by improving the Xavier Yard to create a more welcoming and communityoriented space with the possible addition of hammocks and permanent seating areas. Our vision is for students to have even more spaces on campus where they can relax, connect and work together. Our ticket has also completed multiple student quality-of-life improvement goals set at the beginning of the last term. These include putting a printer in the Village

Apartments, adding dining dollar readers in Cintas, and improving the parking infrastructure in H-Lot. We plan to continue delivering for the student body by expanding dining dollar access to off-campus establishments like the new University Eatz and Arcade. Additionally, we will advocate for the resurfacing of campus roads and walkways. We will advocate for increased street lighting on Norwood roads immediately surrounding campus so that students can feel safe inside well-lit areas both on and off campus. We will strengthen relationships through hosted forums between students and police departments of both Xavier and Norwood to create a safer and more cohesive community. Activating the Cintas Center: We believe that as it exists currently, the Cintas Center is underutilized. We are committed to advocating for more opportunities for student engagement at the arena outside of sporting events. We will build upon existing goodwill with the administration to bring occasions such as concerts, shows, and other entertainment for students to enjoy at Cintas. Civic Engagement on Campus SGA is Listening tables are a pillar of SGA's communication with the student body. During her two years as a Senator, Kathryn has hosted numerous listening sessions to hear directly from students regarding what their concerns from around campus are. Under a Watts-Cohen Administration, these tabling events would be even more frequent and intentional and will include further opportunities for dialogue for students to engage in while stopping by. Our ticket would love to work with the administration to host and facilitate a diverse group of community leaders to speak on campus. We aim to foster open dialogue and stronger connections between Xavier students and our surrounding community.
