ROA (Report of Administration): Scott Clyde, Vice President Student Enrollment Management

- Data Points
- Snapshot of March 30th
- Inquires: college bound high school students
- 2.2 million students that graduate every year from the United States and it includes the students who shared that Xavier may be on their lists.
- Strong Inquires
- Gross deposit: Paid a deposit and say they will be going to Xavier
- Net deposit: Paid a deposit and started college in the Fall
- Census: In September, students that attend in the Fall
- November 20th : First batch of admitted students
- Estimated 1000+ by May 1st (based on data)
- Senator Filigenzi: Applications are down and deposits are up. Is this a trend or usually like this around this time of year?
- Answer: We're up 20% in the admitted students year to year
- Rosario: Is the 1,100 a goal for census? If you budgeted for 1000 students what would happen to those students?
- Answer: Extra revenue would go to areas where more funds are needed. We would invest that money into teaching professors or facilities
