

#### **SWAVE Peer Educators**

Student Wellbeing and Anti-Violence Education

Under the supervision of the Director of Student Wellbeing Services, BRAVE and SWAG have integrated to form a unified peer education team: SWAVE Peer Educators. This group promotes student wellbeing, healthy relationships, and a campus culture of care through evidence-based outreach, advocacy, and engaging wellness programming. Peer Educators collaborate on initiatives supporting mental health, safety, and holistic wellbeing while helping connect students to campus resources. Members gain hands-on experience in education, event planning, communication, and leadership. Peer Educators are expected to serve for the full academic year and will receive compensation. Daytime, evening, and weekend hours may be required.

### **Responsibilities and Expectations:**

- Attend 12 hours of mandatory onboarding training on:
  - Saturday, September 5, 2025 (9am–4pm)
  - Sunday, September 6, 2025 (9am–2pm)
- Complete QPR Suicide Prevention training within first semester of employment (if not certified in the past year).
- Attend weekly 1-hour team meetings (time TBD).
- Hold 2 hours of weekly office hours in the Student Wellbeing Services space (time TBD).
- Co-faciliate programs, events, social media campaigns, etc. related to student wellbeing.
- Submit required workshop paperwork and maintain accurate records.
- Participate in SWAVE leadership development, community-building, and ongoing training.
- Maintain appropriate confidentiality in all matters involving 1:1 peer interactions
- Engage in:
  - Individual check-ins and supervision
  - Targeted outreach to marginalized and/or vulnerable populations
  - Building effective, collaborative relationships across campus
  - Other duties as assigned

#### **Required Qualifications:**

- Students are required to be in good standing. For SWAVE Peer Educators, this means:
  - Maintaining a cumulative GPA of 2.75
  - Not on university or residence life probation
  - Not on Suspension in Abeyance
  - No past due conduct sanctions

- Must be a current undergrad sophomore or junior student enrolled full-time.
- Ability to carry out tasks independently and work in small groups in a student-centered environment.
- Availability to work approximately 5 hours per week during the 2026-2027 academic year.
- Demonstrate awareness of the sensitive nature of the position and importance of confidentiality.
- Facilitate a minimum of 3 programs per semester and administer assessment tools to measure knowledge, attitude and behavior change.
- Intermediate awareness of and interest in wellbeign related topics, education, and services.
- Experience or interest in working with diverse populations.
