- Academic Plan
 - 30 different focus areas
 - Osteopathic medicine, first-year experience, research opportunities, vocational discernment
- Vocational Discernment
 - Develop and implement a holistic, integrated model of vocational discernment
 - Academic Advising
 - Core Curriculum
 - Sophomore Retreat
 - Career Development
 - *What should we call this?*
 - *What do you advise as we start this work?*
- **Q:** Pre-med advising - trouble getting in contact with her. Is it an option to put pre-professional advisors on the portal?
 - Looking into it
- **C:** Advise the people working on this to keep in mind that a lot of people don't know their specific career, so definitely work more on skills that can align with their values and vocation
- **Q:** Would the sophomore retreats be broken down into colleges/majors?
 - We don't know yet, some people might like to be with their major peers or club peers. There might be a couple different options
- **Q:** Are you going to find a way to incorporate clubs into vocational discernment?
 - Good point, we might offer different options so students can match with the right experience for them
- **Q:** Will the sophomore retreat cost money?

- We think it will be included in tuition
- **Q:** Will the content of the SR have the same feel as GOA?
 - The current ones include meeting with recent alumni, reflection on your calling, group conversations
- **Q:** Will these retreats be consolidated with OSI/GOA?
 - We don't want to duplicate, a conversation will be had
 - **C:** Arrupe Leaders might be a good model, too
- **Q:** Will the Summer Service Internship be in collaboration?
 - Not sure, another source to look at for the model to make sure we don't duplicate
- **Q:** Healthcare directed mission -
 - OT, athletic training, health services administration, nursing, counseling
- **Q:** Specific majors looking to use as a model for vocational discernment?
 - PPP (cohort and experiential learning) - but not every major has this pre-existing cohort relationship
- **C:** To encompass the whole process: **Entrance to Excellence**
- **Q:** Is the university looking to make most majors a cohort like PPP?
 - If it makes sense for the major, we'll adopt it
- **Q:** Can we just advise and add to the pre-existing programs?
 - We could, we just want to make sure every student gets the same level of advising
- **Q:** Are you looking at adding programs like the social work with SLU?
 - We're always open, but those are hard to predict because they are tricky relationships
