- Significant value to the students that graduate from Xavier
  - Reports publicly available through institutional resource site
- Data from 14 different areas on campus
- How does Xavier impact the economy of Ohio?
- Student spending impact; bringing in visitors from out of state through programming on campus and in Cintas
- Volunteerism impact; service into the community that has tangible economic value
- Operations spending impact: \$122.6 million
- Research spending impact: \$436.4 thousand
- Visitor spending impact: \$3 million
- More spending generated than some companies in Cincinnati
- \$978 million total income added to the state; 12,766 jobs supported in the state
- Investment Analysis:
  - Student perspective: \$670 million
  - Taxpayer perspective: \$152 million
  - Social perspective \$1.8 billion
  - Every dollar invested in Xavier returns \$6 back to you (ROI being a student)
