# Report of Administration: Bill Moran, Director of Auxiliary Services

- Auxiliary: Retail, dining, campus stores (AFO and Dy 1), mailing services, part of parking (permits and communications), ID services, printing services, markets, laundry services, and banking relationships (U.S. Bank)
  - Business side of campus
- Updating interior door locks in Husman and Kuhlman
- Day 1 fee with first years; new students will have a \$125 fee per semester (everyone else grandfather-ed in)
  - Additional revenue streams needed to be generated in order to keep the Day 1 program alive
  - More transparency; more line items to see where money is going towards in tuition
  - Compared to \$600 per semester alternatively (still subsidized)
  - Students can opt out of the fee

- Renovating Burger 513 downstairs; opening as two distinct venues
  - o Left will be gourmet burger venue, right will be an expanded Absurd Bird
  - Similar pricing as existing venues; bundling may make it look more expensive but more value
- Opening another marketplace; coffee
- Partnering with Sedler Center to open smoothie and bowls area in Smith
  - Student-run and experiential learning
- Parking website will look different because renewed contract; no changes in parking prices
- Caf shut down last week: Fire suppressant system over grills
  - No fires, pests, or toxic
- Dining focus groups wrapped up last week
  - 75 students participated, immediate wins and adjustments such as increased fresh berries, daily steamed vegetable, deli open on the weekends, more baked pasta on weekends
- Conversations with Dr. Moore about open space under U-Station
- Looking into card readers disabled on vending machines throughout campus
- Land in H lot not owned by university, so we cannot pave it but can work to improve the quality of it as it becomes more popular
- Changes to meal plans for residential students on campus
  - Only one option which is the Musketeer Unlimited meal plan; \$250 dining dollars and unlimited swipes
