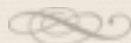


AN IGNATIAN JOURNEY TO THE HOLY LAND:  
HISTORICAL, CULTURAL AND INTERFAITH PERSPECTIVES



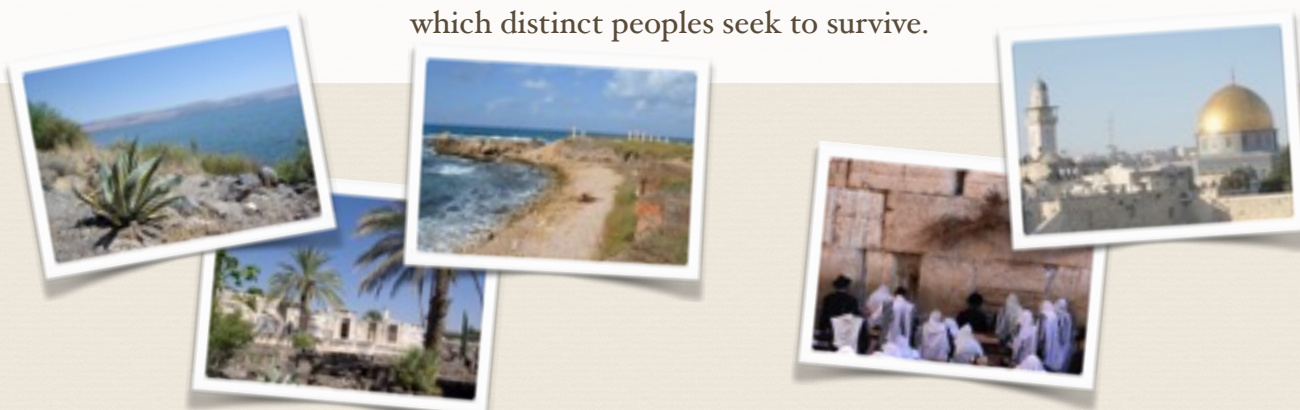
