Summer Study Abroad 2022

Earn up to 12 Credits in Spanish and Core Courses

May 13 – June 4 (3 Weeks)

6 credits in Spanish language, culture, or Historical Perspectives

The first three-week session will include arrival activities in Madrid, an excursion to Pamplona, Roncesvalles (Camino de Santiago), Xavier Castle, and the Loyola Sanctuary with a subsequent stay in Comillas, Cantabria.

Students earn six credits. Projected courses include Spanish language (SPAN 101-300), Culture in Northern Spain, and Historical Perspectives (Spain & Empire – HIST 199)

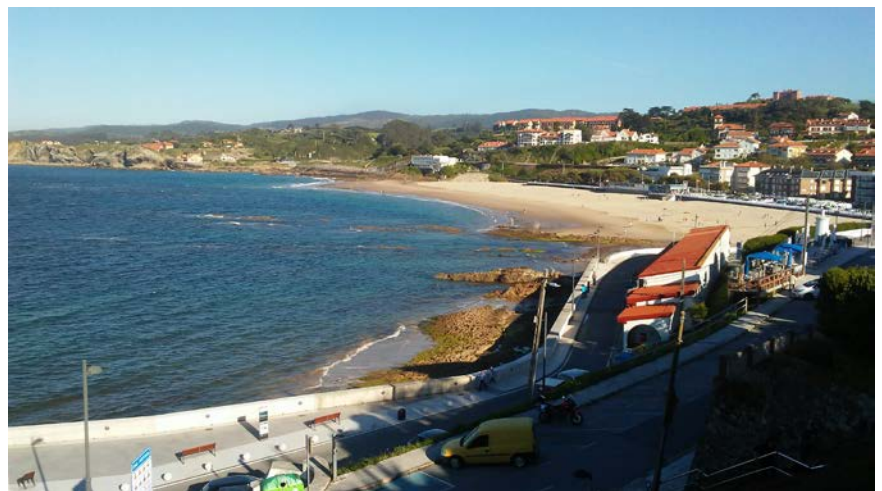
May 13 – June 26 (6 Weeks)

12 credits in Spanish language & culture, Literature & the Moral Imagination, or Creative Perspectives

Students can extend their stay in Spain for a six-week experience. The second three-week session will remain in Comillas and include a hike in the Picos de Europa, a walk along a segment of the Camino de Santiago with a visit to San Vicente de la Barquera, the local folk music festival, and the celebration of St. John's Eve.



Students earn twelve credits. Projected courses include the three-week courses, plus intermediate and advanced Spanish, Contemporary Spanish Culture, Hispanic Literature & the Moral Imagination (SPAN 205), and Creative Perspectives (ARTS 112).
