Connection Center

- Reserve a group study room in the CLC
- Check out a laptop to be used anywhere in the CLC or Library
- Use the copiers, fax, and digital sender available on the 3rd floor of the CLC. Ask for assistance at the Connection Center
- Print from desktops, personal laptops, and Connection Center laptops. Print release stations are located throughout the CLC and Library
- Visit the Digital Media Lab (513-745-4811) located on the 3rd floor of the CLC. The DML provides digital media equipment for borrowing, video/audio editing, and assistance with video projects

- Links to reserves provide access to electronic and physical items assigned in courses



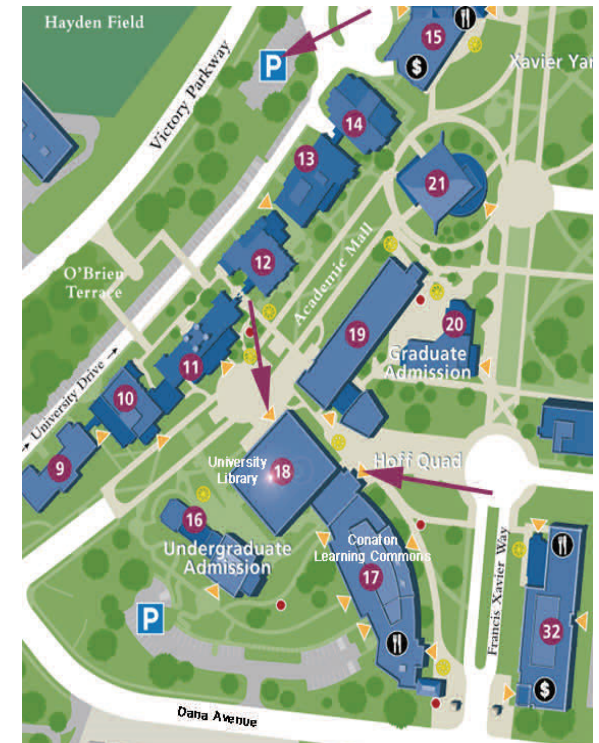
