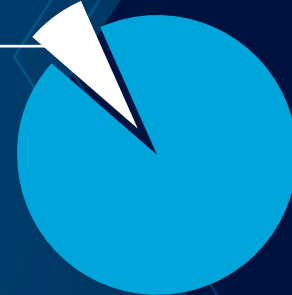

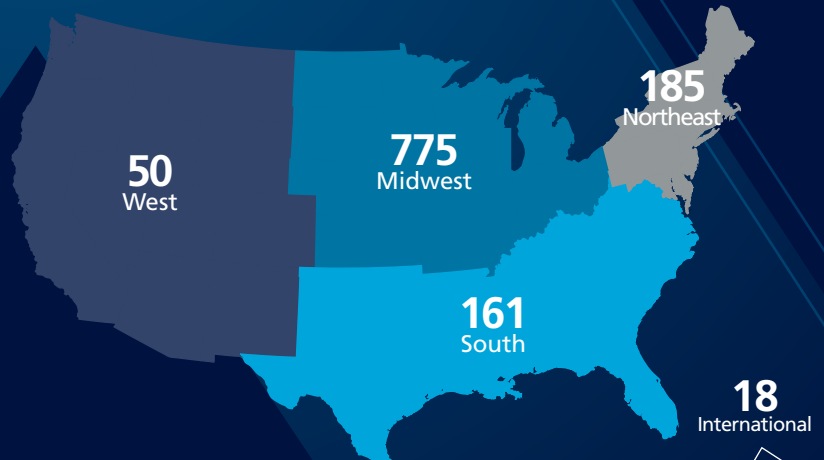

PROFESSIONAL OUTCOMES

- **86%** of Xavier's pre-medical graduates have been accepted into professional schools, compared to 40 percent nationally (5-year average, 2018-2022).
- **98%** of students are employed, attending grad school or working in service or volunteer positions within six months of graduation (Class of 2021).
